

Math Assistance Program (MAP)

The Math Assistance Program (MAP) is a service provided for students who are taking Pre-Calculus (MATH111). MAP is an opportunity to work with peers collaboratively to get questions answered, work on practice problems, and reveal misconceptions about Pre-Cal. MAP sessions are offered each week during the semester by a Center for Student Learning tutor; students can attend as many sessions as they would like and stay for as long as they need. MAP is a free service offered by the Center for Student Learning in partnership with the Math Department.
