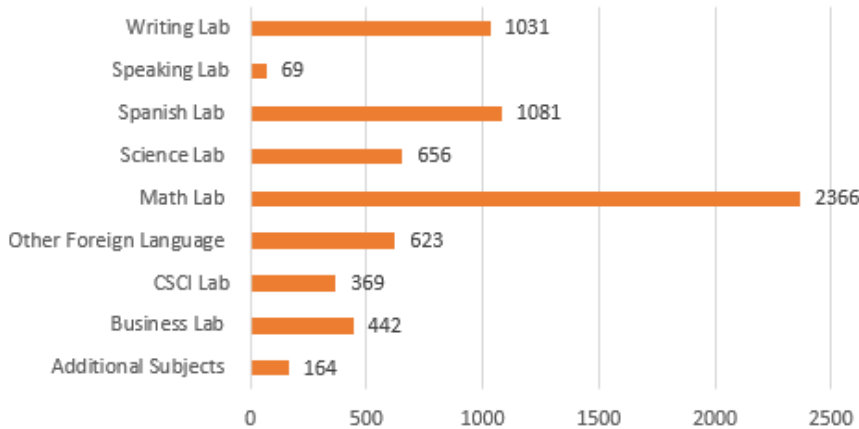

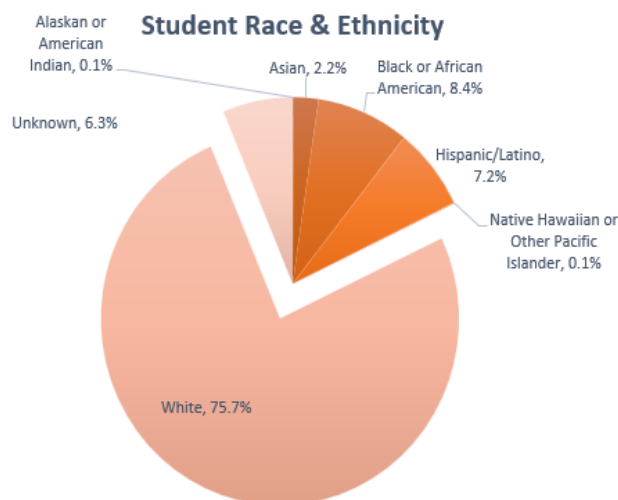

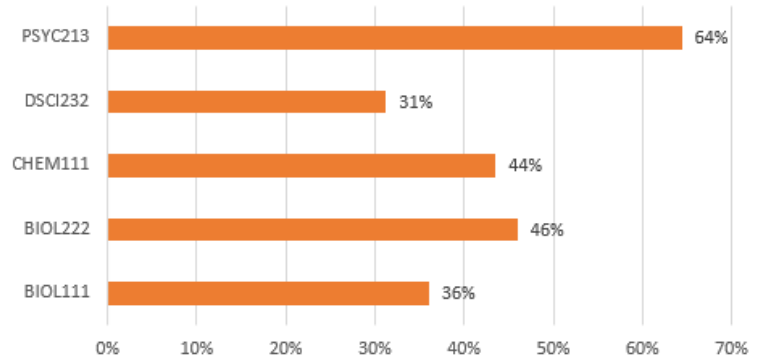

Supplemental Instruction (SI) 2021 — 2022

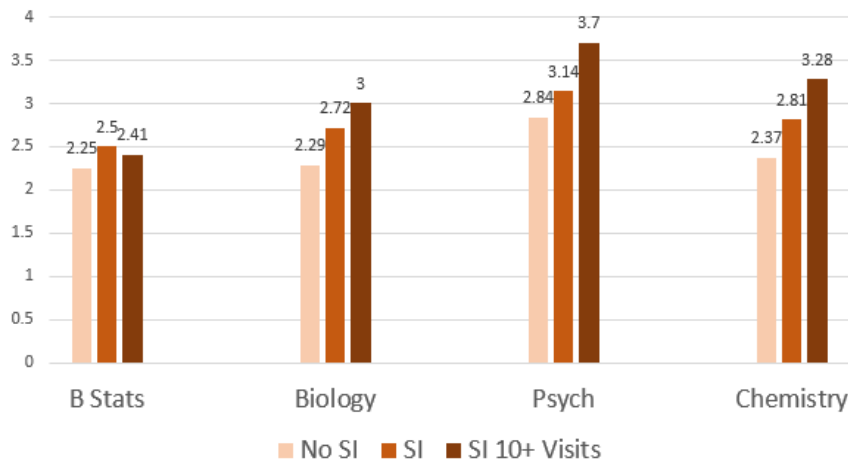

Student Employees Data:

- 172 employees
- 42% of student employees are declared majors in the School of Science & Math
